

A Quality Improvement (QI) Opportunity for Family Medicine and Internal Medicine-Pediatrics Practices

Are you a clinician interested in asking moms, “Care to talk about...your health, too?”

Care2 was developed with both the clinician and family in mind – to spark in-office conversations at well-child visits that can lead to needed interventions and encourage birthing people and care providers to view whole-family health as a fundamental part of well-child visits.

Project Activities Include: forming a QI team, attending monthly webinars to share successes and learn from peers, completing Plan-Do-Study-Act cycles and monthly EHR data submissions.

Improve Interconception Care for Women and Health Outcomes of Children

- Connect with mothers during **well-child visits** to identify risk factors and connect them to appropriate resources and treatment
 - As she considers future pregnancies, use valuable in-office time to consider mom’s health, too
- Utilize enhanced protocols to improve office processes related to interconception care
